- Institute applicants must be journalists who cover the environment at least part time, and come from any of the U.S. states or the Canadian provinces that border the Great Lakes. Roughly 20 print, broadcast, online and freelance journalists are selected.

- There is no cost to apply.

- Applications must be postmarked by April 17, 2009, and fellowship winners will be notified by mid-May.

- Up to 20 journalists are selected.

- Once accepted, fellows must pay \$150.

- Participants must arrange their own travel to East Lansing Michigan, Mich., where the institute begins the evening of June 9.
